WHERE TO USE:		Recommended for interior walls and ceilings where a washable finish is required. Ideal for use on properly prepared drywall, plaster, masonry, wood and metal surfaces.							
Surface Preparation:		 New Work: The surface to be coated must be clean and free of oil, grease, rust and other contaminants that could interfere with adhesion. Priming – Drywall & Concrete – Self Priming or use Pro Prime 4190 Drywall Primer Wood – Block-It 50 Int/Ext Stain Blocking Primer or Alkyd Undercoat 37-11 Plaster – Block-It 50 Int/Ext Stain Blocking Primer Repaint: The surface to be painted must be clean and free of dirt, chalk, mildew, wax, grease, rust stains or loose flaking paint. Remove loose or flaking paint by scraping. Feather sand rough edges to insure a smooth finish coat. Glossy surfaces must be dulled by lightly sanding. Remove sanding dust before paint application. Any exposed substrate should be spot primed with this product or the appropriate primer. When using Vintage as primer/finish at least two coats are required. 							
Application:		 Stir thoroughly with a circular, lifting motion to assure even pigment dispersion. Roller – Use a 3/8" to 1/2" roller cover. Brush – Use a nylon / polyester brush. Spray – May be applied by spray & back-roll using airless equipment. For best results, use quality applicator tools. Do not sacrifice good results by using inexpensive
